

Tire Recycling Service Monroe County

The Monroe County Recycling and Green Community Program and Monroe County Drain Commission have announced this year's tire recycling service for Monroe County residents.

The collection dates are:

May 31, 2017

June 28, 2017

July 26, 2017

Location is at the Monroe County Drain Commission office at 1005 S. Raisinville Rd., Monroe, MI.

Hours are from 9 am to noon, or until the truck is full. Tires will not be accepted at any other time and leaving tires after hours is illegal dumping, which is considered to be a punishable offense.

Participants are allowed to bring up to 20 tires per vehicle and collected tires will be recycled at no charge. All tires must be clean and off the rim. Only passenger vehicle or light truck tires will be accepted.

This program is for Monroe County residents only. Tires from commercial sources will not be accepted. Residents who have large tires to recycle can call the Environmental Health Office at (734) 240-7900 for recycling information.

This program is funded by a grant from the Scrap Tire Cleanup Project through the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality and the County of Monroe.
