Budget Public Hearing & Closing of the Books

The London Township Board will hold a "Budget Public Hearing" meeting on **Wednesday, March 28, 2018 at 10:00 A.M.** at London Township Hall.

Immediately afterward, the London Township Board will hold a "Closing of the Books" and a public hearing on the proposed township budget for fiscal year (2018). ***The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing.** The budgets for General, Sewer, Water, Hack-Rapp, and Liquor Funds will be discussed. A copy of the budget is available for public inspection at London Township Hall at 13613 Tuttlehill Road, Milan, MI.
